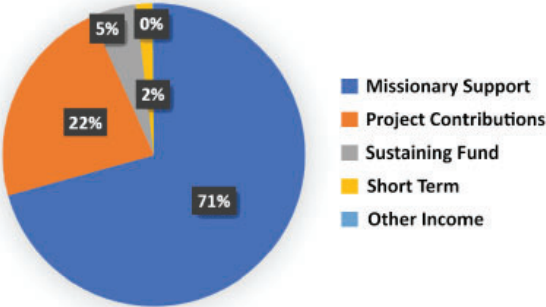
# 2018 Financial Overview

**Total Contributions \$1,271,864**

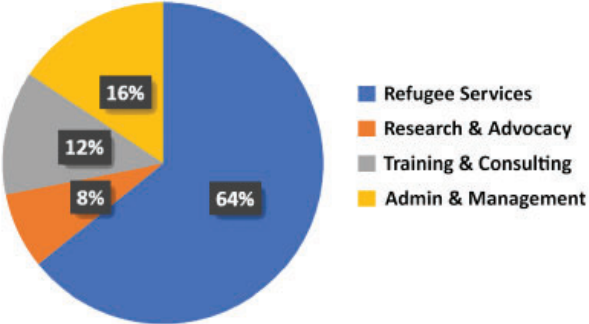


## IAFR EXPENSES 2018
